



Over 100 000 views of the documentary film from the expedition to the FRANKEN (youtube and social media)



In April 2019, the Supreme Audit Office announced an audit regarding "Counteracting the threats arising from the presence of hazardous materials on the bottom of the Baltic Sea". The results of the audit were published in May 2020 confirming the danger posed by wrecks and the possibility of ecological disaster.






2018: FRANKEN EXPEDITION + ACTION PLAN
